How long is the evening?

ca. 60 – 90 Minutes.
The time after the regular time can be used for 1:1 discussions, and is up to the individual.

What happens in this time?

The points on the agenda are available before the meeting (Internet).
The agenda is the basis for the structure of the meeting.

Who is the meeting aimed at?

Students & Holidaymakers who want to brush up their English.
Pupils who are having problems with their homework.
People who want to have as much fun with English as their own language.
A teacher who is looking for creative “input” for their lessons.
Parents who want their children to brush up on their English.
Someone planning their holiday, or wanting to move abroad.
Pensioners who want to get better at complaining abroad.
Musicians who want to explain their deep meaningful lyrics to other people.
Music lovers who want to understand the lyrics of songs they like, or just listen to a stupid explanation.
Artists who want to perform in English. Does it translate into German?
Debaters who want to discuss in English. Heated discussions are always good!
Politicians, English people abroad who miss dry humor, and verbal banter.
In fact, anybody is welcome.

What is involved in learning a foreign language?

Self discipline, like in the sport studio, the teacher is there to remind the trainee that they have to do their sit-ups.

Which themes are discussed?

Those which are on the agenda, but the topics are normally suggested by the participants.
Questions are, as far as possible, answered instantly, and if not, then noted to be answered at a later stage.
